

L3 Case Study: Key Questions in Assessment

1. Case Background & Aims

- Are clear aims and objectives expressed?
- Is the case appropriate in terms of its strategic or transformational nature?
- Is there clarity of context, in the business and perhaps wider market?
- Is there strategic rationale linked to the business?
- Is the candidate's role appropriate?

2. Method & Approach

- Have appropriate and robust methodologies been employed?
- Is there evidence of project organisation and planning?
- Has advanced lean knowledge been used?

3. Results

- Is there a thorough description of results and outcomes, both intended and unintended?
- Is there evidence of appropriate data analysis?
- Is there appreciation and sufficient exploration of any limitations of the results?

4. Conclusions & Endorsement

- Have sound and mature conclusions been reached?
- Is there appropriate stakeholder endorsement?
- Do the conclusions link back to the original objectives?
- Has the candidate reflected sufficiently on the overall experience in terms of personal learning?
- Is there evidence of critical thinking, independent thought?
- Has the wider application of the findings been considered?
- Has potential follow up activity been considered (eg analysis, investigation or research)?

5. Sustainability

- Have sustainability actions been identified, and with the benefit of hindsight, did they work?
- Is there awareness and understanding of sustainability issues, at the time and subsequently?
