The accredited organisation:

- · Can accredit to any number of the seven LCS levels
- · Can change levels covered or certificate volumes at any point
- Has a two year licence (renewable)
- Pays a fee based on volume of certificates to be issued
- Issues personal LCS certificates to learners
- Is committed to maintaining standards and improving its programme or system
