OPERATION OF THE POLLS

Using Mentimeter polls to generate interaction & insights → prepared questions

- You can make snap comments on poll results
 - Display for a few seconds in the Presentation before they disappear (and not saved for exporting).

SETTING UP MENTIMETER POLL PRESENTATION

STEP 1: Invite

- You will receive an invite to the Mentimeter poll
- Click **View** → Mentimeter app for Zoom should open in a new window (if installed)

STEP 2: Share

- The poll presentation will be launched and you can vote inside the Zoom meeting

If App not installed:

- Click **Add** → **Authorise** → back to Zoom meeting & click **Open**

*Note: Do not be in full screen mode in Zoom to see voting panel clearly (**exit full screen** in top right)*
